

Frequently Asked Questions About Voting

1. When is the Bond Referendum Vote?

Answer: *December 16, 2008. Polls are open from 7:00 AM to 8:00 PM.*

2. Where do I vote for the school bond?

Answer: *The voting poll locations are as follows:*

Rowley is the Community Center at 109 Ely Street.

Brandon is the Community Club at 802 Main Street.

Independence is Heartland Acres Event Center, 2600 Swan Lake Blvd.

3. Do I have to vote in person on December 16th?

Answer: *No, you can avoid the lines at the polls by requesting an absentee ballot and voting in advance. Simply drop by the Buchanan County Auditor's office or go to www.people4progress.org and click on 'Register to Vote'. You can print off the Absentee Ballot Request Form. You may also call the People 4 Progress Board co-chairs and they will be happy to arrange pick up your absentee ballot request form and drop it at the Buchanan County Auditor's office.*

4. What is the deadline for requesting an absentee ballot and sending in my absentee ballot?

Answer: *The last day for the County Auditor to receive a Voter Absentee Ballot Request and to mail a Voter Absentee Ballot is **December 12, 2008**. The last day to vote absentee in the County Auditor Office is **December 15, 2008**.*

Note: *Absentee ballots must be postmarked by December 15th or sooner; after that date, the absentee ballot will not be valid.*
